In April, 2018, the below described Bobcat loaders and Felling trailers were rented from a rental business in Chicago, Illinois. As of this date, indications are that false information was used to rent the equipment, and it cannot be located.

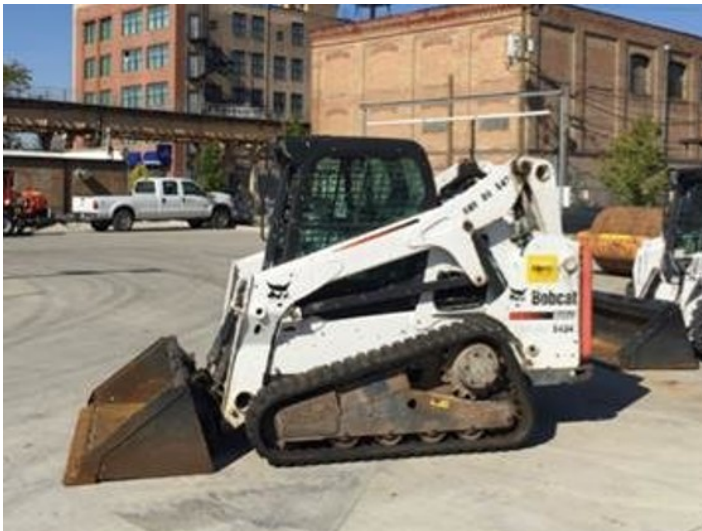

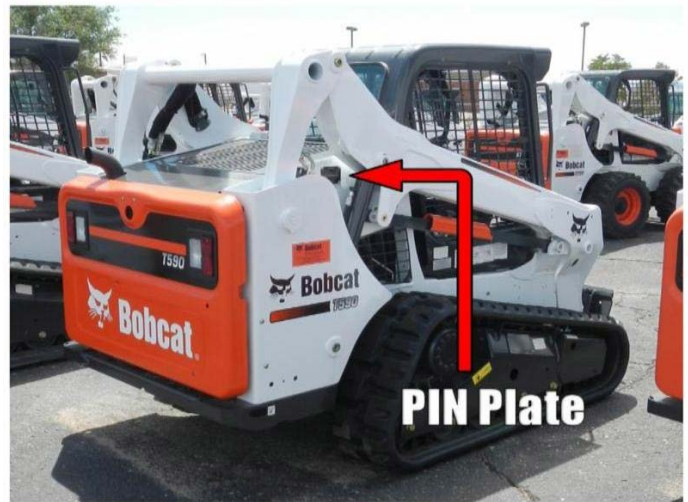
