The stolen Case IH 8940 is assumed to be a 4 wd tractor, but details on tractor's configuration are unknown at the time of this alert. The tractor PIN plate is on the left side of the base of the dash console, facing out. This must not be confused with the ROPS/Cab serial number plate that is just inside the left door on entry threshold.
