The stolen John Deere 6110-M with loader is confirmed to be a 4wd cab tractor. The tractor PIN plate is on the right frame above and rearward of the front axle.

The stolen Case IH 8940 is assumed to be a 4wd tractor, but details on tractor's configuration are unknown at the time of this alert. The tractor PIN plate is on the left side of the base of the dash console, facing out. This must not be confused with the ROPS/Cab serial number plate that is just inside the left door on entry threshold.
