

Equipment Theft Alert

New Mexico Gehl, Bobcat Skid Steers 4/4/2018

On Wednesday morning April 4th, 2018, workers discovered that the below described Gehl and Bobcat skid steers were stolen from a fuel station construction site at I-25 and Camino Del Llano, Belen, New Mexico. A trencher was heavy damaged and abandoned near I-25, and the ignition and controls on a backhoe were damaged.

Please forward this alert to anyone that may have witnessed activity at the location, and to investigators working on similar thefts.

The serial number decal on the Gehl machine is above the right loader boom, on the inside surface of the loader structure, near the hinge pin.
