Monday October 30th, 2017, the below described Kubota Tracked Skid Steer was left on a job site at 11565 Tamiami Trail E, Naples, Florida. This morning Tuesday October 31st, the machine was discovered missing and presumed stolen.



The detail illustrates the machine PIN plate and the cab ROPS plate locations. The ROPS serial number does not identify the machine and must not be confused as the machine PIN plate.
