Texas Caterpillar Grader 11.21.2017

Between Thursday November 23rd and Monday November 27th, 2017, the below described and pictured Caterpillar Grader was stolen from a job site on the north side of <u>Highway 114 in Irving, Texas</u>, between Estes Boulevard and Freeport Parkway. Thieves may have accessed the site from a dirt road off of West Royal Lane, and hauled the machine out the same way.
